



Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act Notice

Breast Reconstruction Surgery Benefits

A mastectomy that is covered by your health plan includes benefits that comply with the Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998, which provides for:

- Reconstruction of the breast(s) that underwent a covered mastectomy.
- Surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to restore a symmetrical appearance.
- Prostheses and coverage for physical complications related to all stages of a covered mastectomy, including lymphedema.

You'll pay your usual deductible, copay, and/or coinsurance. For details, contact your plan administrator.
